Subject choices

All students study six subjects selected from the following groups. Three are studied at Standard Level and Three at Higher Level. These are the options available to Rome International School students.

01 Studies in Language & Literature

FIRST LANGUAGE - ALSO CALLED AN A LANGUAGE

English, Italian and Chinese (Arabic A or B)

02 Language Acquisition

SECOND LANGUAGE - ALSO CALLED A B LANGUAGE

English, Italian, Chinese, French, Spanish and Arabic as a second language

03 Individuals and Societies

History, Economics,
Philosophy and Global Politics

04 The Sciences

Biology, Chemistry, Physics

05 Mathematics

From September 2019, there will be two strands of Mathematics to choose from. They are Analysis and Approaches and Applications and Interpretation. We can give advice as to the most appropriate choice for your child.

06 The Arts

We offer a very practical multi-media approach to the creation of works of Art. However in Group 6, students are not obliged to study the Arts. They may study a second subject from Group 1,2,3 or 4 (a third language or a second Science or Humanities subject).
